

When you click on any of the Survey Phase Maps, you will see the map appear, but it will be rotated once clockwise.

To view the map upright, do the following:

In Internet Explorer:

- 1) Click on the Phase Map you want to view
- 2) Once the sideways map appears, you can either:
 - a) Right-mouse click (brings up the shortcut menu)
 - b) Click on 'Rotate Clockwise'
 - c) Do a & b above two more times for the map to appear upright.

OR

- a) Press & hold the Shift & CTRL keys, & while pressing Shift & CTRL, press the '-' key. This will automatically upright the map for viewing.

In Firefox:

- 1) Click on the Phase Map you want to view
- 2) Once the sideways map appears:
 - a) There is a '>>' symbol in the upper righthand corner
 - b) Click on the '>>', & click on 'Rotate Counterclockwise'
 - c) This 'uprights' the map for viewing

In Chrome:

- 1) Click on the Phase Map you want to view
- 2) Once the sideways map appears, you can either:
 - a) Right-mouse click (brings up the shortcut menu)
 - b) Click on 'Rotate Counter Clockwise'
 - c) This will automatically upright the map for viewing

OR

- a) Click on the 'circle with arrow' symbol in the upper righthand corner
- b) Click on this symbol 3 times
- c) This will automatically upright the map for viewing

To preserve the fine print detail of these maps, they were downloaded directly from Coconino County Recorder, & then stored here for viewing. Additional modifying [to make them display upright] diminishes the print quality & the ability to read the small numbers.*
